

Ordinance NO. 3-5-90

RE: ISSUANCE OF THE WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING PERMIT

WHEREAS, cities, villages and towns with a population of 2,500 or less are now required by Section 101.65(3), Wisconsin Statutes, to issue the Wisconsin Administrative Building Permit as prescribed and furnished by the State of Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations; and

WHEREAS, any person or persons desiring to build a new one-family or two-family dwelling would presently need to obtain a zoning permit from the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department; and

WHEREAS, it would be more convenient for all parties involved to delegate the authority to issue Wisconsin Administrative Building Permits required by the State of Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations through one central administrative location; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Lanark to delegate this authority to the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Supervisors of the Town of Lanark as follows:

The Portage County Planning and Zoning Department is hereby delegated the authority to issue the Wisconsin Administrative Building Permit as prescribed and furnished by the State of Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations on behalf of the Town of Lanark
