Computers, laptops, printers, televisions, computer peripherals, fax machines, DVD players, VCRs and other video players (i.e., DVRs), phones with video displays

# SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING. ALL RECYCLABLES CAN GO IN ONE CONTAINER

Please rinse containers and combine with paper items, glass & flattened cardboard  
no recyclables in plastic bags

## Accepted

#1-#7 Plastic Containers. Check to ensure the item has a recycling triangle symbol.



### #1 - #2 PLASTIC

#### CONTAINERS:

milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, soda and water bottles. Emptied and Rinsed.

### #3 - #7 PLASTIC

#### CONTAINERS:

food, beverage, deli, ice cream, yogurt, cottage cheese, bakery, pill, medicine & kitty litter containers. Emptied and Rinsed.

### #3 - #7 PLASTICS:

Flower pots or trays, clear rigid clam shell packaging, 5 gal. pails, small toys.

Must fit into bin.

**NO STYROFOAM!**



### DO NOT put LARGE

#3 - #7 plastics on the curb



DO bring them to the Transfer Facility to recycle for free:

plastic 55-gallon drums (triple rinse),  
large plastic furniture (chairs, tables, etc.)  
& large plastic toys (playhouses, slides, etc.).

## Recycle The Following Items:



**NO SHARPS**

**PAPERS:** Office paper, Junk mail, Envelopes (with or without windows), Catalogs, Magazines, Newspapers, Phonebooks, Paperback books, and Paper bags. Flatten all: Paper egg cartons, Contain-erboard, Cardboard, Rolls & Tubes

**CANS:** Aluminum (do not crush), Steel (push partially attached lid into can) deliver all other scrap metal directly to Transfer Station

**PLASTIC:** Bottles, Jugs & All Plastics # 1 - 7

**GLASS:** Jars and Bottles, (No window glass)

**NO SHARPS**

**BRING** the following items to the Portage County Transfer Facility:  
Some have a fee, others are free. All are recycled!



Sharps, plastic film, shrink wrap or bags (any #); Brown #1 plastic; Plastic straws, plates, silverware; Drink pouches; Frozen food containers; Food; Styrofoam (egg cartons, hot beverage cups, plates, formed packing pieces, or packing peanuts); Foam/Polystyrene; Aluminum foil & baking pans; Metal or plastic liners; Motor oil containers; Light bulbs; Mirrors; Window glass; Ceramics; Clay pots; Tissue products; Paper towels; Soiled paper; Dirty cardboard; CD cases; Vinyl (siding, etc.).
